



# Chatham Community Players SPRING AFTER-SCHOOL THEATER CLASSES TUESDAY AFTERNOONS - APRIL 16 TO JUNE 4

Tuition - \$120/class

All classes take place at The Chatham Playhouse *THE JOY OF IMPROV (ages 12-17)* 3:30 pm

Students will explore the fundamentals of improvisation through exercises and games while developing spontaneity, playfulness, imagination, and self-confidence. Listening and verbal skills will be enhanced, as well as individual creativity.

#### INTRODUCTION TO MUSICAL THEATER (ages 7-11) 4:30 pm

Designed for young performers itching to get on stage, this class provides a foundation in musical performance style and vocal technique, and will help them gain the confidence to stand center stage.

ADVANCED MUSICAL THEATER (ages 12-17) 5:30 pm

In a class designed for students with previous training and/or experience in musical theater, participants will nurture their emerging performance skills, increase musicality and vocal technique, and enhance their ability to act through a song.


