

#### **DIRECTOR'S NOTE**

When deciding how to direct *A Christmas Carol*, we really felt we wanted to stay true to what Charles Dickens wrote: a ghost story. By telling this ghost story, the haunting of Ebenezer Scrooge, we are also able to tell a human story.

Many of us are haunted by our past and that keeps us from being an active participant in our present. Many of us are haunted by our thoughts about the future and because of that we sometimes bring to pass what we fear most. However, it is through the story of Ebenezer Scrooge that we can see a way out of the haunting. We can forgive ourselves in the past, be present in the present, and hope for a bright future. This version of *A Christmas Carol* also gives us the gift of watching Charles Dickens learn along with the audience and Scrooge so that he too can feel the power of Christmas again.

On a lighter note, a ghost story needs spectacle and we set out to do just that. To create a world of magic and jubilation just like musical theater itself. For us it has been an absolute joy to work on such a classic story with this amazing cast. We have felt the meaning of Christmas throughout this process and in this whole show. We hope you all do too.



#### A love letter to A Christmas Carol, from Leslie and Joëlle...

I (Leslie) had the great privilege of being cast as Belle in the inaugural production of *A Christmas Carol*, directed by the author himself, Philip Wm. McKinley. When the cast assembled for the first read through and heard the music for the first time, many of us wept - all of us knew we were about to be part of something extraordinary. The experience proved so powerful, the Trustees along with Phil invited the entire cast to reprise their roles the following year. With few exceptions, we all returned.

I (Joëlle) did my first acting on this show in 2001, and rehearsals began right around the time that the Twin Towers fell. The pain we all felt seemed to merge with Scrooge's cruelty. His redemption became ours in the months that followed; opening night, we realized how strong the healing power of theater could be.

When the 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary production rolled around, the cast was assembled from alumni. Joëlle was invited to play Mrs. Dickens and Beatrice. Director Jeffrey Fiorello felt strongly about including a cast member from the original Chatham production and invited me (Leslie) back, this time to play the Charwoman and Emily. And here is where Joëlle and I finally got to share the onstage magic together.

In 2020, when the world shut down, then President Joe DeVico offered to create a filmed version. Joe acted as producer, music director, and with the assistance of Ed Whitman, filmed and edited the production, directed and choreographed by veteran *A Christmas Carol* director (11 times!), Susan Speidel. The cast was formed by alumni and families to keep the pod small and Covid at bay. Joëlle and I got to reprise our roles of Laundress and Charwoman! The show was offered online for a small minimum donation (\$2) – our gift to our audience, during some of the world's darkest days.

The magic of this show permeates through hundreds of crew and cast members – some who even met on this show and eventually married. Some cast members have grown to see their children in the cast years later. For audience members as well, some saw our first production in 1988, and are now bringing their grandchildren to today's performance, keeping a family holiday tradition.

Welcome to the magic. Welcome to our family. Thank you for joining us and making our holiday tradition your holiday tradition this year. We hope you continue to make it your tradition for years to come. Bless you... every one!
